

Grade 7-12 Supply List 2010-11

- **Looseleaf binders** - several smaller ones are preferred over one or two large ones. Large binders do not fit in the lockers.
- 500 sheets **looseleaf paper** - some in each binder
- one transparent **ruler**
- (Gr. 7-8 only) one **geometry set** (a fairly good set is a much better buy than a cheap set that works poorly and last a short time)
- **Hi-Liter pen**
- package of **pencil crayons**
- **pens** (blue or black ink **ONLY** and no Gel pens please)
- HB lead **pencils or mechanical pencil**
- **pencil case**
- **Dictionary** - should have 90,000 - 140,000 entries and **Thesaurus**
- one good **pencil eraser** (white eraser is preferred)
- one pad of **graph paper** for Sr. High
- **Bible** (we suggest the New International Version as this is the version used for Scripture memory. We do have inexpensive, hard cover NIV Bibles available for sale at the office.)
- one pair of **scissors, scotch tape** and a **glue stick**
- **Gr. 10's** - **Duotang** and an extra 1" **binder with 5 dividers** and page protectors
- **Gr. 9-12** - **USB Flash Drive**
- **Kleenex** (one box)

Calculator:

Grade 7-9 - inexpensive scientific calculator. (Sharp - model # EL510RB).

Grades 10-12 - each student taking Math (with the exception of students in the dash 3 stream) must have access to a Texas Instruments TI-83 Plus, or TI-84 Graphing Calculator. **Warning:** please do not download programs off the internet onto your calculator.
