

## OKCS Grade 7-12 Supply List 2018-19

- 2 (2") binders
- subject dividers (1 set)
- correction tape
- pencil sharpener with reservoir
- 500 sheets **looseleaf paper** - some in each binder
- one transparent **ruler**
- **2 Hi-Liter pens**
- package of **pencil crayons** (Art 10/20/30 - Prisma crayons suggested)
- **pens** (blue or black ink **ONLY** and no Gel pens please)
- HB lead **pencils or mechanical pencil**
- **pencil case** (double zipper cases suggested)
- **Dictionary** - should have 90,000 - 140,000 entries and **Thesaurus**  
**Gr. 11-12:** Merriam Websters School Dictionary and the Canadian Oxford High School Dictionary are acceptable for Diploma Exams.
- one good **pencil eraser** (white eraser is preferred)
- **Bible** (we suggest the New International Version as this is the version used for Scripture memory. We do have inexpensive, hard cover NIV Bibles available for sale at the office. If purchasing one, buy the 2011 version.)
- one pair of **scissors, scotch tape** and a **glue stick**
- **Kleenex** (one box to homeroom teachers)
- **Gr. 7/8:** 2 red pens
- **Gr. 7/8:** - one **geometry set** (a fairly good set is a much better buy than a cheap set that works poorly and last a short time)
- **Gr. 8** - coil notebook
- **Gr. 8-12:** one pad of **graph paper**
- **Gr. 7-12** - **USB Flash Drive**
- **Gr. 10-12:** pkg. **AAA batteries; pkg. AA batteries; highlighters**

### Calculator:

**Grade 7-9 & students in 10-3; 20-3; 30-3 streams** - inexpensive scientific calculator.

**Grades 10-12** - each student taking Math (with the exception of students in the dash 3 stream) must have access to a Texas Instruments TI-83 Plus, or TI-84 Plus Graphing Calculator.

**NOTE:** In order to be successful on diploma exams, it is necessary to practice using a thesaurus and dictionary throughout Gr. 10-12. Please see that students have these at school and available when called for. Thank you.
