As you plan for your child to attend kindergarten, this is an ideal time to review your child's immunization history. It is important to keep your child's immunizations up to date in order to prevent disease and to help keep them healthy.

Children are due for the following routine vaccines at 4 years of age:

· Diphtheria / Pertussis / Tetanus / Polio

These immunizations are provided free of charge.

Immunization Records: any Albertan can submit immunization records, including out-ofprovince/country records at Immunization record submission (alberta.ca)
